	20/0798/CEA Lawful Development Certificate (S192 Proposed Development) Use of building as dwelling to care for children at The Bungalow, 45 Albert Street, Brierfield	
	That the Planning, Economic Development and Regulatory Services Manager be granted <b>delegated</b> <b>authority</b> to <b>approve</b> the Lawful Development Certificate once the Chairman has spoken with Councillor Hanif who was absent from this meeting, but had expressed concerns about this application.	Decision notice to be issued.
2.	Environmental Blight That the issue of fly tipping on the car park at the rear of Brierfield Community Centre be referred to the Environmental Services Manager.	As the carpark is private land, the Council cannot take the lead in investigations or the removal of flytipped waste but assistance can be provided if evidence of an offender is found by the landowner and is left on site enabling an investigation to commence. At this stage evidence is currently being sought.
