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PROGRESS REPORT ON ACTION ARISING FROM COLNE AND DISTRICT COMMITTEE ON 8TH JULY, 2021

1. **Progress Report**

...Councillor S. Cockburn-Price reported that Trawden Forest Parish Council had considered this Committee's request for a contribution towards the Wycoller Beck Footpath Stabilisation Project. However, the Parish Council had felt that there was an alternative, cheaper solution to the one proposed which they were currently exploring. It was noted that the Parish Council had not yet discussed this with the Council's Countryside Access Officer, but planned to do so shortly.

The suggestion put forward by the Parish Council is already within the project plan, which involves buying the land, formally diverting the footpath, dismantling and re-building the existing drystone wall, installing drainage and carrying out stabilisation works to prevent further erosion. The matter is being considered further by the Parish Council.
