3. Items for Discussion

(a) Lighting at Macmillan/Sure Start Nursery, Railway Street/Brunswick Street, Nelson

That the Housing, Health and Engineering Services Manager be asked to submit a report to the next meeting on the cost implications for the provision of adequate lighting on the footpath between Brunswick Street and Railway Street, Nelson above the Macmillan/Sure Start Nursery site in Nelson.

(b) Junction of Scotland Road/Sagar Street/ Broadway Nelson

That once a decision was known on the Towns Fund bid the Housing, Health and Engineering Services Manager be requested to submit a report to a future meeting of this Committee on proposals and costs for the possible widening of the junction of Scotland Road/Sagar Street and Broadway, Nelson.

(c) Removal of Bus Shelter at Waidshouse Road, Nelson

That the Housing, Health and Engineering Services Manager arrange for the bus shelter to be reinstated as soon as possible.

(d) Chapel House Road, Nelson – Speed Calming Measures

That the Housing, Health and Engineering Services Manager be asked to submit a report to a future meeting of this Committee on options and costs for the introduction of speed calming measures on the full length of Chapel House Road, Nelson.

(e) Broadway Car Park, Nelson – Measure to Restrict Access to the Car Park

That the Housing, Health and Engineering Services Manager be asked to submit a report to a future meeting of this Committee advising on the cost and options available for the Nelson Town Council have been asked to fund the lighting repairs.

The Bus Shelter was removed by the developer of a nearby site and is part of the S278 agreement to have it replaced in a similar location. LCC are liaising with the developer to have it reinstated with the same specification to the Quality Bus shelters.

This would need to be referred to the Traffic Liaison Meeting first for their comments.

The Council are currently looking at installing height barriers on several of the Nelson Town erection of a height barrier onto the Broadway Car Park, Nelson.

Centre car parks in order to alleviate any future issues with unwanted vehicles on these car parks. A report will be submitted to a future meeting once costings have been received.

(f) Pendle Valley Mill Practice
