7) Brief details - In May 2019 a Pendle Borough Council CIF bid enabled us to install 3x CCTV cameras at Happy Valley crossroads in Roughlee, a major junction between Pendleside villages. They cover all vehicles using Barley New Road, Blacko Bar Road, Ridge Lane and Jinny Lane and as such can be used for assisting police investigations across Roughlee, Goldshaw Booth and Barley as well as further afield. In just two years they have proven their worth; supporting police investigations on at least 12 different occasions including 4 road traffic accidents, 6 burglaries and 2 major fly tipping incidents. However, a consistent challenge is capturing number plates at night - the 'night vision' technology on the existing cameras (bi-spectrum image fusion technology which combines features from thermal and optical images) results in glare on the reflective plates. Having explored options, we now want to install 3x ANPR (Automatic Number Plate Recognition) cameras to capture this data more effectively using infrared vision. This can then be used for police investigations to supplement the existing visuals as required. In terms of operation, we have already got GDPR and data protection policies in force, which with only slight modifications can protect this additional data.
8) Main outcomes - Further improve support for police investigations across all Pendleside villages by providing number plate data during the night at the major junction of Happy Valley crossroads
