RESULTS OF APPEALS/PROSECUTIONS

PURPOSE OF REPORT

To report, for information, the decisions of appeals/prosecutions since the last meeting.

PROSECUTIONS

1. Usman Arif

Usman Arif was charged with driving a private hire vehicle without holding a private hire drivers licence and for driving a private hire vehicle without insurance on 11th and 12th May 2021.

He pleaded guilty to the offences and was given 8 points on his driving licence and fined \pounds 120. He was ordered to pay a contribution to our costs of \pounds 100 and a victim surcharge of \pounds 34.

2. Pendle Taxi Ltd – Mohammed Azam Chaudhry

Pendle Taxi Ltd – Mohammed Azam Chaudhry, was charged with being the proprietor of a vehicle and employing a driver who did not hold a private hire drivers licence; as an operator, operated a vehicle as a private hire vehicle without the driver holding a private hire driver's licence and failed to keep a record of bookings as the Council require by condition attached to his private hire operator's licence.

He pleaded guilty to all 3 offences and was fined £200. He was ordered to pay £150 contribution to our costs and a victim surcharge of £34.

IMPLICATIONS

Policy: Consideration should be given as to whether they are fit and proper to hold or be granted a licence.
