Colne Town Centre Re-opening

PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1. To report to the committee on the RHSSF (Re-opening the High Streets Safely Fund) grant funding for Re-opening of Colne Town Centre.
- 2. To report to the Committee on the Welcome Back Fund (WBF)

Recommendations

1. To update the committee on the RHSSF spending for re-opening of Colne high street

Reasons for recommendations

1. In order that the Committee remains apprised of developments concerning the spending on the Re-opening of Colne Town Centre

1. Current Position

Remaining funding from RHSSF for Colne is £4,370

In addition the new WBF Allocation of £20,299

TOTAL Amount is £24,669 for Colne to spend

Approximately £3,000 to £4000 is needed to be used to pay for the installation of the totems.

2. Spending Decisions

As previously approved by the September committee it was agreed that the WBF grant be spent on events activities in the lead up to Christmas.

An updated list is attached as APPENDIX 1

Quotes and company details are being supplied by Colne BID and Pendle BC is ordering these as per the grant conditions

Three quotes will need to be obtained were the services/goods procured are over £2500. All quotes will need to be to PBC and all orders go through PBC.

Totem signs – Hartley Square site is being secured from a legal/land perspective and an alternative site is being investigated to replace the railway station site.

As suggested at the last meeting the siting of the second totem at Colne Leisure Centre is being explored with all the concerned parties (PLT, PBC engineers, PBC Legal etc)
