Amount requested: £ 600.00 (total estimated project costs of £1200)
<b>Brief details of Project:</b> The access from the end of Westfield Road to Victory Park is up a short ramp to the park. This is a link path of public footpaths 5 and 6. We received a report from a local person that the surface condition is poor with loose stone on the surface. Due to the slope of the ramp this makes access difficult for people with limited mobility, parents with push chairs and so forth. The project proposal is to strip off the poor section of surface and relay a bit-mac surface with concrete edgings, over an area of 12.5m x 1.9m, with all surfaces flush to the adjoining paths. The footpath runs between the end of the adopted road and public footpath 5.
Main Outcomes to be Achieved: Improved pedestrian access from Westfield Road to Victory Park.
