4. EXCLUSION OF THE PRESS AND PUBLIC

AGREED

5. PROGRAMME UPDATE AND RISKS

The Housing Health and Engineering Services Manager provided an update following discussions involving project leads, the Council's new JV partner and the Cities and Local Growth Unit (CLGU) in relation to a request to extend the deadline for the development of two business cases which had been recommended to the Board at the last meeting.

The Board discussed assurances around Government approval; assurances and issues around the late start and catch up along with general assurances around the speed of the current programme.
