A. Short project title: Public Footpath 31 improvements - Skipton Road to Holme Crescent, Trawden (project ref 9270).

D. Amount requested: £5000 (total project cost is £8,800)

E. Brief details of project: The footpath between Skipton Road and Holme Crescent has fallen into disrepair because large cracks have opened up in between the concrete flagstones which form the footpath surface. The project is to take up and dispose of the flagstones (these will be recycled), level the existing steps, resurface with tarmac including concrete edgings, and install a handrail on one side.

F. Main outcomes to be achieved: The project will improve a footpath linking an area of housing with the main road in Trawden.

G. When will project be implemented? H. Who will undertake the project works? The design and supervision of the scheme will be by the Council's Senior Engineer within Engineering, Health and Housing Services. The contract will be awarded to a suitable company by a competitive tendering process for completion during the 2022 – 23 financial year.
