

8. <u>Traffic Issues on Wilton Street, Barrowford</u>

The Housing, Health and Engineering Services Manager reports that a quote has been received to construct the parking area at Location B, identified in the report submitted to the meeting of this Committee held on 8th June, 2022, which, together with the relevant Planning Application fee, will result in a total cost of £8,638.
