To seek out and co-ordinate funding opportunities in support of delivering against our strategy priorities. 5. To ensure that the work of the Group is both strategically and operationally aligned to other strategic boards and co-operates on priorities. 6. To Feed into Lancashire wide forums where opportunities exist for wider strategic engagement.
