1.	<p><u>Community Safety Issues and Police Matters</u></p> <p>RESOLVED</p> <p>That –</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (1) clarification be sought on the legislation for dealing with abandoned vehicles; (2) should it be permitted under the legislation, the Council's Community Protection Coordinator be asked to serve notice for all cars currently abandoned in the Colne and District area; (3) a database of abandoned vehicles be created. 	<p>A meeting has taken place at which the Deputy Police and Crime Commissioner was present. The legislation and the options for the Police, DVLA and DVSA were discussed. There is a difference between a vehicle which is truly abandoned and one which is still in use but not taxed, insured or with MOT. A partnership approach is being taken to deal with the issue.</p>
