

At a meeting of the West Craven Committee on 3rd January, 2023 it was resolved "that £300 be allocated from the Earby and Coates allocation of the Area Committee Budget; funding be released from the Section 106 funding for flooding work in Earby; and the Policy and Resources Committee's Special Budget meeting be asked to consider including funding for the scheme in the Council's Capital Programme in the event that this funding be needed to allow the work to proceed.

The Director of Resources advises that any new capital scheme needs to be appraised prior to being added to the Capital Programme to understand the financial and non-financial risks associated with the scheme. No S106 funding has been identified for this scheme.

RECOMMENDATION
