Our Next Event on May 14th 2023 is based around the village green. Performers are as follows: - Maypole and dancers (Malkin Morris), Story Telling and Crafts, Danny English, We Be Kids, Folk Music Musicians, local Morris dancing groups, a Magician, Craft fair, Tug of War and hot food. We wish to purchase high quality traditional games i.e Quoits, Hook a Duck. Giant Connect Four, Aunt Sally, Coconut Shy, Beat the Goalie etc. We also intend to purchase a Gazebo to use at the event and to lend out to our community groups in Earby. There will also be free workshops at Linden Rd leading up to the event to teach local people basic Maypole dances and Malkin Morris is working with Springfield Primary School to deliver Maypole dancing sessions which include an element of historical and social education.
