Brief updates to identify **key points** and **partnership actions** required:

- Police (MATAC analytical report)

Dominic provided an update via presentation.

Work being done to secure Pendle Rise.

Sainsbury's have been reluctant to do anything about fuel drive-offs. Jerry has asked new manager to pick this up via Colne BID.

McDonald's, Colne – PAC and CYAG doing work with them to reduce ASB

PAC – just secured detached youth work contract for ASB. Use hotspots and timings to inform their work.

Working with YES Hub – doing some work in Nelson, with the Police.

- Domestic Abuse Services – PAC and LVS

Increase in direct referrals. Work with LVS to avoid duplication.

Reminder to LVS that we need the data. Ask them to provide a presentation at the next meeting.

- Fire and Rescue Service

No report and no representation.

- Inspire substance misuse

Nikki Major, now back in Pendle. In Sept-Oct, there were 52 referrals. Majority self-referrals alongside other agencies referring in.

Wayne – any prospect of improvements? Hill View – remote (*Tim – did you get more detail on the ask, please?*)

- Pendle Borough Council - Community Protection Update

DHR – final overview report to go back to Chair then Home Office.

5. Forum Updates

- Burnley & Pendle Exploitation Awareness Group (Claire Bennett)

Training/information sharing with local businesses – who may spot incidents/behaviours. Tie in priorities with that of Pendle and Burnley's CS priorities.

- Pendle Domestic Abuse Forum (Claire Bennett)

Returning as a face to face group. Using local data to update their plan in the new year. Work planned for DA week in November to raise awareness. VAWG – integrated into this work.

- Colne Community Safety Area Working Group (Jerry Stanford)

BID has joined the group – joint meeting of residents and businesses.

John Sutcliffe attended – Nelson and Colne Police teams now working together.

Concerns around youth ASB.

Been contacted by Walking Connects Project – adults 50+ socially isolated and at risk of loneliness.
