1. Declaration of Interests

A Member must declare a disclosable pecuniary interest which he/she has in any item on the agenda. A Member with a disclosable pecuniary interest in any item may not participate in any discussion of the matter at the meeting and must not participate in any vote taken on the matter at the meeting.

In addition the Council's Standing Orders require a Member with a disclosable pecuniary interest to leave the room where the meeting is held while any discussion or voting takes place.

4. <u>Taxi Safety and Measures to Improve Public Safety</u>

In order to make the trade safer for passengers and drivers, suggested changes to the taxi policy were put out to consultation earlier this year. A report which outlined the issues and provided details of the consultation responses was considered by this Committee in March, and a number of recommendations were submitted to the former Policy and Resources Committee for approval.

Enc. At the request of the former Policy and Resources Committee a Task and Finish Group was set up to look at improvements to taxi safety. The notes of the Group's meeting held on the 11th July are submitted for information.

The Committee's attention is drawn to the Task and Finish Group's decision that members of the trade be given a further opportunity to submit, in writing, their proposals for improving taxi safety and the requirement that these be submitted within three weeks of the date of the Group's meeting.

Members are advised that no written proposals have been received, therefore the Committee is recommended to request Council to approve the proposed changes to the taxi policy as agreed by the Task and Finish Group.

5. <u>Hackney Carriage Demand Survey</u>
