1. Declaration of Interests

A Member must declare a disclosable pecuniary interest which he/she has in any item on the agenda. A Member with a disclosable pecuniary interest in any item may not participate in any discussion of the matter at the meeting and must not participate in any vote taken on the matter at the meeting.

In addition, the Council's Standing Orders require a Member with a disclosable pecuniary interest to leave the room where the meeting is held while any discussion or voting takes place.

Whipping declarations are also required.

4. Proposed Reviews

Strategic Leisure Review

At the request of the Executive, the Committee is asked to consider convening a Task and Finish Group 'to examine how the three leisure facilities in Colne, Nelson and West Craven could be made to be financially viable through retrofitting and renewal; to consider the mix of features taking affordability into account; and to consider operating models for the future taking account of what was needed to ensure delivery of requirements for each leisure facility'.

If agreed, this Committee shall agree the membership and appoint the Leader of the Task and Finish Group. Any non-Executive member is eligible to sit on the Group which ideally, should be no more than 6 members.
