## PROGRESS REPORT ON ACTION ARISING FROM COLNE AND DISTRICT COMMITTEE ON 5<sup>TH</sup> OCTOBER 2023

	Two residents referred to parking and traffic issues caused by school traffic on Gill Street and Francis Street, Colne. They asked if measures could be put in place, possibly for a temporary period, such as bollards, or the introduction of a School Street Scheme.	Noted.
	The matter had been raised at the earlier Colne and District Community Safety Working Group where it had been noted that the issue had been escalated as part of a Problem-Oriented-Policing (POP) exercise which involved working with the nearby schools. Lancashire County Council (LCC) was also aware of the issue.	
	The couple was advised to collect data to support the case, by recording the times when problems occurred, with photo/video evidence where possible. In the meantime, further contact would be made with the local school.
