

8. Flooding Issues/Risks

To receive the below updates on issues raised at the last meeting. There will also be an opportunity for any new issues to be raised.

Flooding Issue on Red Lane, Blacko

Lancashire County Council is planning to arrange a road closure in the New Year to allow for works to address an issue with a blocked/restricted outlet on Red Lane, Blacko near its junction with Barnoldswick Road to be undertaken.

Flooding Issue on Sabden Road, Higham

Lancashire County Council (LCC) was requested to investigate a potential underlying issue that could be contributing to flooding on Sabden Road, Higham.

LCC had received a report of a blocked gully from the Clerk of Higham with West Close Booth Parish Council on 19th March, 2023 and the gully pump had attended on 23rd March, 2023 to clear the blockage. Since this report LCC had not received any further reports regarding drainage problems on the road.

LCC have advised that any further issues need to be reported via the Love Clean Streets webpage (<u>https://www.lancashire.gov.uk/roads-parking-and-travel/report-it/flooding-and-drainage/</u>) or app (<u>https://www.lancashire.gov.uk/roads-parking-and-travel/report-it/report-it/report-it/con-the-go/</u>) so that inspections can be made and works considered. Higham with West Close Booth Parish Council have been recommended to make this report.
