TWINNING UPDATE

An update on twinning events was circulated.

Re. International Youth Meeting 2024 in Marl, notification had not yet been received from Marl as to whether funding for this project had been confirmed.

Re. Marl-Pendle staff exchange, the itinerary for the 2 staff from Marl coming to Pendle later that month was outlined. It focussed on looking at Pendle's regeneration projects. It included tours of Nelson Town Hall, the Accessible Nelson scheme, Northlight and the Steven Burke Sports Hub and BMX track. It also comprised a tour of Colne's Heritage Quarter, featuring The Muni Theatre, Pendle Hippodrome and The Little Theatre. A Spring get-together of Pendle Twinning Association was part of it, followed by a visit to a Pendle Community Orchestra rehearsal. The visit would be finished with a drive around the Masterplan areas of Barnoldswick and Earby and a walk up Pendle Hill to give the visitors a full overview of the borough. Accommodation and airport transfers for the 2 Marl staff were being provided by 2 Pendle twinning members, as previously agreed. The aim was to look at different approaches and solutions and share knowledge.

For the enquiry re. a Mr. N. Rowley, The Vice-Chair had found out a little more information and advised she would continue looking into this.
