3. Planning Applications

Enc. The Assistant Director Planning, Building Control and Regulatory Services submits the attached report on the following planning application for determination –

24/0107/FUL Full: Change of use to permit vehicle servicing and repairs to existing car sales on Site of Former Garages, Bradley Road East, Nelson

At a meeting of Nelson, Brierfield and Reedley Committee on 7th May 2024 the decision to approve this application was referred as a recommendation to this Committee as the development would amount to a significant departure from policy ENV5 of the Local Plan: Part 1 Core Strategy and would likely result in a detrimental impact upon residential amenity. The Planning Officer's recommendation is to refuse this application.
