1. Welcome

6. Consultants Presentation

Lauren Newby from Ekosgen provided an update on Phase 1 of the public consultation both with Key Stakeholders and the Pendle wide community.

The Board were updated on the Shortlisted Interventions based around the 3 key themes.

All available interventions had been RAG rated to consider performance against the critical success factors: support for identified needs, contribution to target outcomes, maximising existing investment and deliverable within three years.

Board members were asked to share their thoughts on the shortlisted interventions, the visual approach and on the vision.

Following this feedback the next steps are to refine the list of interventions and potential actions ideas through Round 2 of the consultation and to advance thinking on the visual approach and vision for the next Board meeting, whilst recognising that form needs to follow function.
