The Head of Economic Growth reports that the full public consultation exercise on Lancashire County Council's and Jacobs' Safer, Greener, Healthier Streets (SGHS) designs for the triangular piece of land at Brunswick Street, originally scheduled for mid-June, has now been moved to July due to the UK Parliamentary General Election.

12. Former Mansfield School Site

Lancashire County Council (LCC) have confirmed that the former Mansfield School site needs to be retained for Education purposes. However, in the short-term, LCC are considering a request for a portion of the site to be used as a compound area in connection with a

development in the locality. LCC are minded to progress with this request in order to minimise disruption to the local roads and traffic.

In terms of the condition of the site, LCC have arranged some works to improve its appearance including litter picking, grass cutting, vegetation removal and fence repairs and residents should expect some activity on site in the coming weeks.
