

- Untidy/derelict piece of unregistered land requiring tidying up and maintaining.
- Untidy/derelict piece of Council-owned or unregistered land which needs regenerating (e.g. a former garage colony converted to a landscaped parking area).

9. Flooding Issues/Risks

Flooding Issue on Blacko Bar Road, Roughlee

Lancashire County Council (LCC) has raised an order to undertake a CCTV inspection of its drainage infrastructure near Bradley's Barn/access into North Farm on Blacko Bar Road, Roughlee to ascertain exactly where the problem is. This job has been prioritised as 'Normal' and it may be some time until it is progressed, unless LCC have a need to review the priority i.e. surface water flooding or property flooding is being caused.
