E. Is there match funding for the project from elsewhere?

If so, please give details: £1,000 from Colne BID, painting from Colne Town Council's Lengthsmen, £530 from Barnfield Construction, £650 outside The Market from the Market Levelling Up Project, preparatory work by Elisha House volunteers.

Brief details of project: We are trying to restore all the cast iron bollards in Colne after LCC threatened to replace them with plastic, which would be completely inappropriate in the Albert Road Conservation Area. As you can see, we have lots of matched funding, so this is the final run of 20 bollards on the PCCU side of Market Street, not including Richmond Court. Elisha House volunteers have given them a first coat, so this would be for a light rub down, a top coat and two coats of gold for the rings at the top. Colners have already admired the ones outside St. Bart's which were completely recently, thanks to a grant from Colne Area.

F. Main outcomes to be achieved: To restore Colne's Town Centre bollards, preventing further rust damage and adding traditional gilding.
