- 9. Brief details of project: The Museum seeks funding for the purchase and installation of projection equipment and associated items. This will enable us to construct an audio-visual area at the Museum. The A/V projector will be sited in an area which is currently under-utilised. There will be provided a seating area which will be accessible to disabled visitors.
  - We need to purchase certain electronic equipment, to augment that which we already have acquired, together with a quantity of fixtures and fittings. The equipment will also allow us to show archive material when visiting local schools when we give illustrated talks on the Mill and the textile history of Pendle.
- 10. Main outcomes to be achieved: An A/V display will greatly enhance the visitor experience. It will allow the presentation of much archive material which is otherwise unseen. Some of this material is the property of the Mill, some may be potentially externally sourced on loan, but all relates to the history of the Mill itself and of the local area and this is in support of the Museum's objectives to "advance the education of the public in the history of cotton weaving and other related subjects of engineering, textile and industrial heritage..."

11. When will project be implemented? Start Date: The project will begin as soon as funds are known to be available. Expected Completion Date: The duration of the works is likely to be 4-6 weeks excluding testing/commissioning

- **12. Who will undertake the project works?** Bancroft Mill volunteers will undertake most of the work, with local qualified tradesmen engaged as necessary
