 he has only attended two meetings in the last 14 months, with his apologies being given at
 meetings of council since May 2023, the only time he has attended full council.

Council resolves to request that Councillor Ormerod resign with immediate effect, and that the Conservatives be requested to implement proper vetting procedures in choosing council candidates.
