Members are reminded of the legal requirements concerning the declaration of interests.

A Member must declare a disclosable pecuniary interest which he/she has in any item on the agenda. A Member with a disclosable pecuniary interest in any item may not participate in any discussion of the matter at the meeting and must not participate in any vote taken on the matter at the meeting.

In addition the Council's Standing Orders require a Member with a disclosable pecuniary interest to leave the room where the meeting is held while any discussion or voting takes place.

3. Appointment of Chief Executive (Head of Paid Service)

**Enc.** Lawrence Conway is the Council's Interim Chief Executive.

Rose Rouse, Pendle BC's former Chief Executive, left the Council's employment in March 2025. A recruitment exercise for a replacement permanent Chief Executive has been undertaken and that process has now concluded. The Interviewing Panel of the shortlisted candidates (Senior Management Appointments Committee) has offered the position to Dean Langton (subject to confirmation by the Full Council) and he has accepted.

Under the law and the Council's constitution the appointment of the Head of Paid Service is subject to confirmation by the Full Council.

Subject to Full Council's approval of the appointment, Dean Langton will take up the position of Chief Executive on 6<sup>th</sup> October, 2025

### **RECOMMENDATION**

That the appointment of Dean Langton as Chief Executive of Pendle Borough Council including designation as Head of Paid Service, Returning Officer and Electoral Registration Officer be confirmed.
