1. The Bungalow, Dam Head Farm, Blacko Bar Road, Roughlee Lancashire	3764	Delegated	10/02/22	17/03/22	17/04/22	Enforcement Notice served requiring the owner to demolish the building. Meeting on site with owner and Parish 14/12/23. Agreed programme of clearance to be completed before the February 2024 Area Committee meeting. Hearing listed on 2 nd October 2024 for non-compliance. Didn't turn up at Court so arrest warrant issued. Pleaded not guilty – trial set for 29 th July 2025

2. Land South of Heights House, Heights Lane, Fence	3944	17/11/22	28/11/22	09/01/23	09/02/23	Enforcement Notice served requiring the owner to permanently remove the caravan from the land and cease using the land for non-agricultural purposes and to remove all the hardstanding and sub base material and reinstate the grassed field and wall to its former condition. Appeal dismissed. The defendant pleaded guilty in court on 22 nd May 2024 and was fined. Further work undertaken which needs to be checked on site for compliance. Planning to check. JBG and NW visited site. Asked for updates on outstanding matters. Awaiting response.
3. Land adjacent Pasture Barn East, Pasture Lane, Barrowford	1783104	Delegated	16/05/25	20/06/25	20/09/25	Enforcement Notice to cease using the land for any purpose other than agriculture and to remove the mobile structures, wooden decking, fire pits, logs and other items. Not guilty plea. Trial 19 th March 2025. Prosecution withdrawn due to legal issues. Further EN served 16/05/25 Appeal received
