4. Pharmaceutical Needs Assessment

Blackburn with Darwen, Blackpool and Lancashire Health and Wellbeing Boards (HWBs) are currently consulting on the 2025 draft Pharmaceutical Needs Assessment (PNA). The PNA describes the needs of the citizens of the area for pharmacy services and includes information on:

- pharmacies across each HWB area and the services they currently provide
- maps of providers of pharmaceutical services across each HWB area
- pharmaceutical contractors in neighbouring HWB areas
- potential gaps in provision and likely future needs for the population of each HWB area
- opportunities for existing pharmacies to provide local public health services

The Committee is invited to provide a response to the draft PNA.
