If so, please give details: We are fundraising by holding raffles, £121 has been raised so far, with a New Year's Eve raffle being held. We estimate Dales View Park Residents Association could top up raffle funding to £650 with a contribution from our balances. We have also approached the local Masonic Lodge and Salterforth Parish Council for a donation/funding. We do not know if these will be successful as we've not heard back from them. We will need to cover the cost of electrical installation and have the relevant permission from the landowner.
- 9. Brief details of project:**
We are a community for over 45 years of age, though most are retired. Currently there are 98 homes on the park, with planning permission for several more. We are situated over a mile from the centre of Barnoldswick and nearest defibrillator. Our aim is to provide a community defibrillator with easy access to all residents. BHF recommend that you should "be able to access equipment within a 2 minute brisk walk. We would place the defibrillator in our library which is a central to the homes. It would be housed in a heated cabinet to keep it at the required temperature. This will require an electricity supply.

10. Main outcomes to be achieved:

Having a defibrillator on site could provide additional minutes and help to increase the chance of surviving a heart attack while waiting for emergency services to arrive and could save lives
