I am writing to support the review of the premises licence (AJS Bar) on the following grounds.

I have consistently been affected by noise nuisance from live bands and amplified music escaping from the building, particularly weekends Friday's Sat, Sun. late at night.

The venue is frequently linked to antisocial behaviour including, shouting, antisocial behaviour, intoxication in the immediate vicinity of my home. People leaving the premises often and loiter outside my property this being on many occasions, people coming round the back of AJS right in front of my house (where there are bushes (urinating + vomiting and on many times have been peed on with vomit and mess near my premises); slamming of car doors late at night; engaging in rowdy behaviour which has been bad over time. The noise from live bands and amplified music has been so loud, I cannot sleep, and can be heard over my T.V. I haven't been able to open my windows at times due to these events and in the summer should be able to open them at my ease.

I attend outside the property with people smoking and standing around throwing down cig ends.

This has been going on now over a period of almost 2 years. from ~~some~~ 2024 up to present date (28/02/26). I have reported all issues that have affected me to environmental health along with the noise app on my phone which I have used many times and also in touch via the app or email to the environmental protection officer with certain occasions reported to the police reporting recordings via the app 29 TIMES in 2024 18 TIMES in 2025 + 5 TIMES 2026 also providing logs

(via the messages on the noise app with reports submitted from 28th June 2024 x 30 times from ~~some~~ 24 until Dec 24. reporting messages in app from June x 3 July x 2 Aug x 4 Oct x 5 Nov x 16 Feb 25 x 5 April 25 x 2 May 25 x 7 July 25 x 8 Sept 25 x 4 Nov + Dec 25 x 4 Jan + Feb 25 x 12 messages + reports via app.

I have previously mentioned via complaints to Environmental health relating issues.

may I also mention at many times glasses left around and broken glass from glasses the night before which haven't been removed/cleaned up before closing. This has also proved a problem with parked cars and residents all disturbances have been audio evidence + time stamped logs via the app and held by environmental health - Penle borough council. all this has impacted my health, inability to sleep + sleep deprivation, feeling unsafe and intimidated. This has been persistent + recurring problem over the years which I have attempted to resolve over the two years but management have failed to address it.

may I add AJS at weekends seem to be the last to close from other bars in area + this causes problems with intoxicated people entering AJS.

This has been quite at times ^{recently} and have proven they can be quite when they choose to the current quintess is unrepresentative of the last two years. on this note I feel like it could revert back if nothing is done therefore may I suggest outcomes of Enabling live music + outdoor drinking at an earlier time eg 10 o'cepa or even stepping live music altogether, installing noise limiting device by the council, requiring SIA-registered door staff to manage street and people leaving outside. as of the passed two years persistent failure to meet licensing objectives. This does not reflect the persistent and severe noise nuisance I have suffered in the past since June 2024. I look forward to hearing from you. Kind regards.
