8. **Brief details of project:** Our workspace is extremely cold in the winter which puts shedders off coming along. It also contributes towards higher energy costs. The main source of cold is currently a winch void between the 1st and ground floor. This project would involve removing the winch, installing floor joists, adding new flooring and building an insulated partition wall to the ceiling. Lastly we would include necessary electrical points as needed to power tools/provide lighting located in the new area.
