

NOTICE OF AN ITEM NOT IN THE FORWARD PLAN

If a matter which is likely to be a key decision has not been included in the schedule of key decisions, then, subject to Rule 16 (General Exception) of the Council's Access to Information Procedure Rules contained in the constitution the decision may still be taken if:

- (a) The decision must be taken by such a date that it is impracticable to defer the decision until it has been included in the next Forward Plan and until the start of the first month to which the next Forward Plan relates.
- (b) The Head of Legal and Democratic Services has informed the Chair of the Overview and scrutiny Committee, in writing, of the matter on which the decision is to be made.
- (c) The Democratic Services Manager has made copies of that notice available for public to view on the Council's website www.pendle.gov.uk
- (d) At least five clear working days have elapsed since the Democratic Services Manager complied with (a) and (c) above.

Where such a decision is taken, it must be taken in public.

Notice is hereby given that a decision in relation to Tenders for delivery of the Crisis Payment Scheme and for the Ghyll Cemetery Scheme will be submitted to the Executive on 27th August 2026.

The reason for the exception is as detailed in (a) above.
