EARBY MEMORIAL BOWLS CLUB GRANT APPLICATION TO WEST CRAVEN COMMITTEE

Earby Memorial Bowls Club was established in 1924 and plays its home fixtures at Sough Park. It has a pavilion and green which was previously maintained by Pendle Borough Council. Unfortunately, this relationship was terminated 2 seasons ago. Since then, the Club has taken on the lease and maintenance of the green and pavilion using fund raising monies and membership fees to do so. There have been several instances where the green has suffered damage to the green caused by either e-bikes, scooters or motorbikes. This has obviously caused much distress to members and brought about additional costs to repair the damage.

The need for CCTV has been exacerbated by an incident on Saturday 22nd August. A member of the Club who had been watching Kelbrook Phoenix play football left whilst the game was still in play, leaving via the front of the park. Two girls were playing football on the bowling green. The Club member simply asked them to play somewhere else rather than on the green. The girls told their father who was also watching the football. He then assaulted the bowling club member, knocking him to the ground, injuring his shoulder and causing trauma to his ear which resulted in a laceration and bleeding. The police were informed and an investigation is in progress.

Earby Memorial Bowling Club now believes that CCTV is required to protect its assets and members from future harm and therefore welcome any contribution from available sources such as West Craven Area Committee.
