

Additional information relating to the Legacy Fund bid from St Michael and All Angels Church, Foulridge

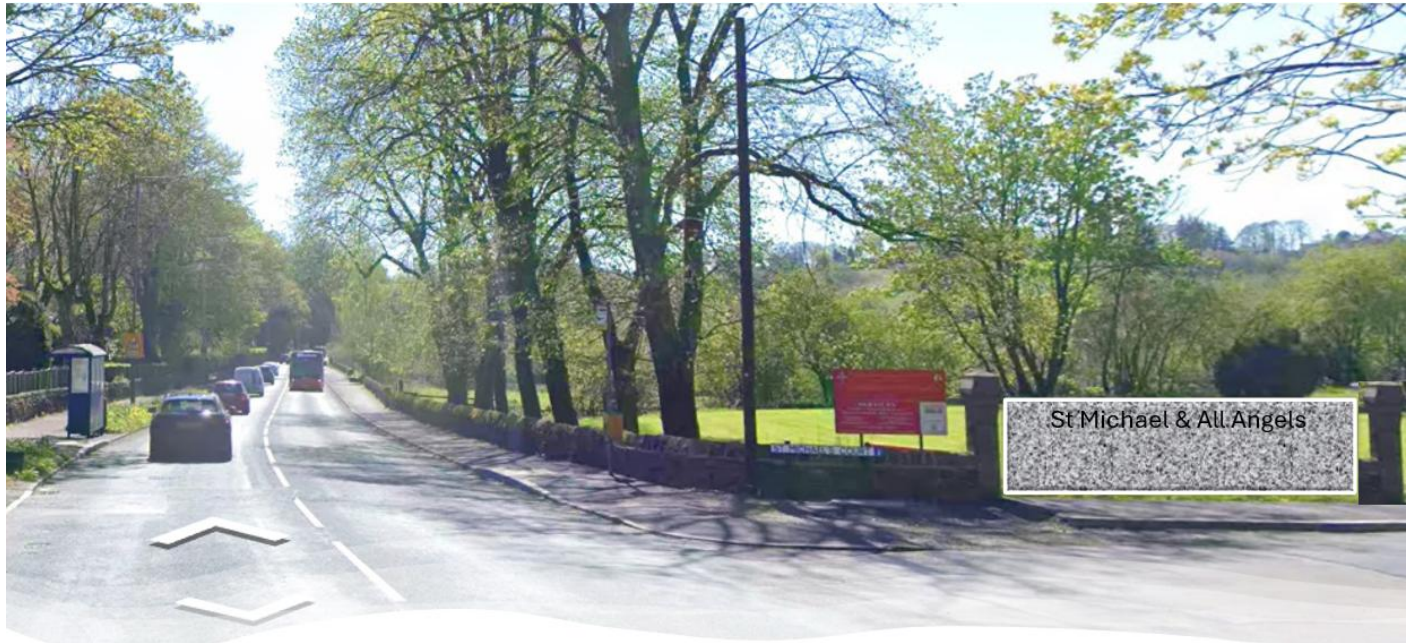
As stated in the application, the Gates were purpose-built to go across the driveway, something which is no longer practicable given both the widening of the road and the fact that the driveway is now the access road to the houses in St Michael's Court.

We have considered a number of options for their new position, but the PCC eventually decided that they would make maximum impact if they were positioned at the entrance to the driveway, close to their original position, but running parallel to the driveway, rather than across it.

Here is what the gates looked like in their original position and in all their original glory:



And this is where we intend that they be re-erected -



The left-hand gatepost is the original, whilst the matching right-hand post has kindly been donated - it currently forms part of the garden wall, but is completely hidden beneath ivy.

The gates will be welded together, as they will now form a decorative and symbolic feature, rather than a practical one.

As can be seen from this Google Streetview picture, the wording across the top of the gates of "St Michael & All Angels" will be clearly seen not only by every car that turns into the driveway, but also to every car driving south on the A56 towards Colne.
