

Colne Town Centre Bus Service Improvement Scheme: Progress Report – as at 10/09/2026

Work on Phase 2 of the Colne Town Centre Bus Service Improvement (BSIP) scheme started on site on Tuesday 1 September, with the site compound and welfare facilities now established. The site compound is located in the corner of the Cross Skelton Street car park (by agreement).

As part of the initial phase of the scheme, the construction team is installing new tactile crossing points at a number of road junctions on Market Street. These works are being carried out under localised pedestrian management arrangements and are not expected to affect traffic flows.

The main highway improvement works on Market Street, Craddock Road and at the Keighley Road/Skipton Road junction are scheduled to start from 5 October 2026. Surfacing works on Market Street are currently planned for mid-October and will be carried out during night-time working.

Further information on traffic management will be shared in advance.

We are also carrying out informal engagement regarding servicing arrangements at Richmonds Court, where proposals are being developed to formalise the existing water barriers and bollard and provide a continuous footway.
